

International Online Symposium Neuroblastoma

WEBINAR

Dear colleagues, dear friends,

It is my great pleasure to invite you to the third International Online Symposium on Neuroblastoma. Over the past two years, this meeting has grown into a valued forum for the international community, and I am delighted that we can once again bring together leading experts to share their knowledge and experience.

The treatment of high-risk and relapsed neuroblastoma remains one of the greatest challenges in pediatric oncology. This year's program follows the patient's journey across the different lines of treatment and reflects the breadth of innovation shaping the field: from surgery to molecularly guided and immunological approaches, and on to the translational research that will define tomorrow's therapies.

Prof. Jörg Fuchs, one of the most renowned surgeons in the field, will open the scientific program with strategies for the resection of complex neuroblastomas, highlighting the surgical decisions that shape outcomes in high-risk disease. Prof. Hedwig Deubzer from Charité – Universitätsmedizin Berlin will then present REDEFINE, a clinical trial evaluating the role of advanced imaging techniques in the assessment of neuroblastoma. Dr. Pablo Berlanga, from Gustave Roussy in Paris, will outline the new SIOPEN guidelines for the treatment of relapsed and progressive ALK-aberrant high-risk neuroblastoma, offering practical guidance on the role of targeted therapy. Prof. Holger Lode from the University of Greifswald will address chemo-immunotherapy for relapsed and refractory high-risk disease, drawing on his extensive experience in anti-GD2 immunotherapy. Finally, Dr. Toby Trahair from Sydney Children's Hospital will broaden the perspective toward the laboratory, presenting patient-derived xenograft models as a powerful tool for neuroblastoma translational research.

As in previous years, this symposium is designed to foster the exchange of clinical experience and scientific knowledge at the highest level. Through expert presentations and interactive discussions, we aim to provide a comprehensive overview of current standards and emerging concepts in neuroblastoma care.

We look forward to your participation in what promises to be an inspiring and insightful meeting.

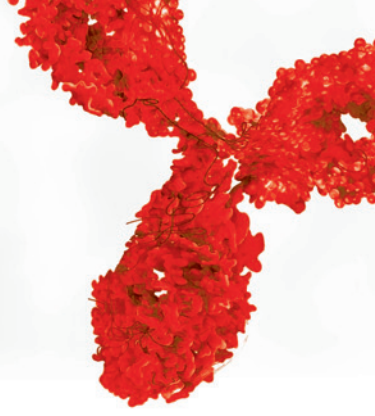
